Registration Process

(1) PREPARE

- Review camps and lodging options. Create a list of preferences.
- Tip: Create a free member account at Autistically Inclined to save time at the checkout.
- Determine your camp payment plan. Learn more on our <u>3-Day</u> <u>Camp page</u> and contact your funding service coordinator.

(2) BOOK

- Go to our <u>3-Day Camp page</u> at the time of registration.
- Tips: Refresh your browser page often. Have other family or friends help register, especially for multiple camps.
- Select your camp and lodging choice.
- Pay \$200 Deposit by credit card, Venmo (rec), or PayPal.
 - Note: This must be paid out-of-pocket, regardless of funding.

(3) FINALIZE

- Complete our Participant Intake Form and Camp Waiver the same day as paying your \$200 deposit. Allow 15-40 min. to complete.
- Pay the invoice for full camp payment that will be sent within 5 business days of completing these forms.

Funding Sources

PROVIDERS

- We are NOT a vendor of the California Regional Center. However we are vendored with Self Determination funding agencies and many families have had success receiving funding through Self Determination.
- Some families have had success using CA Regional Center funds under Social Recreation.
- We also have had some success accepting Class Wallet and ESA funds for Arizona Families, if applicable.

COVERAGE

 Self Determination typically covers the cost of the Regional Center client (eg: Programming Fee + Meals + Lodging for the camper) but other family member costs typically have to be paid out of pocket (meals).

COMMUNICATION

- Every Regional Center is different. We recommend contacting your service coordinator for details to learn what they will cover.

Info for Funding Agencies

ABOUT CAMP

- We do not teach spelling methodologies at camp.
- Staff: Our staff have a variety of expertise, including SLPs, OTs, Music Therapists, Assistive Technology Specialists, Massage Therapists, etc.
- Inclusion: Our camp provides inclusive camp activities and experiences for textbased AAC users and their families.
 - There is nothing experimental about connecting with friends at camp and receiving professional support from a wide variety of practitioners.

- Communication Requirements: All families must have some level of experience with high-tech or low-tech, text-based AAC, since we do not teach communication methods at this camp.

PAYMENT POLICY

• All participants pay a \$200 nonrefundable deposit to secure their spot. Full payment from guaranteed funding agencies is due within 30 days of camp commencement. No refunds will be issued unless the spot is filled by another participant. If the spot is filled and the program is paid in full, a refund minus the \$200 nonrefundable deposit will be issued.

ADJUSTMENTS

- Exceptions: As with any typical business, our expenses are dependent upon each of the spots being filled at camp. If your agency expects differently, please email us your guidelines for our review. If you need a specific refund policy in order to receive funding, please let us know what you need. We are happy to help.
